C 5 - 10 points
D = Short easy walk normally 4mls max, 3 – 6 points
S = A shorter and much slower option to the main 'A' walk, not necessarily a summit. May be on rough terrain.

D Walk, Wednesday July 9 - Burton Point and Farm, 3 miles / flattish

This is a stroll through farmland, where are no public footpaths. Briefly enter RSPB reserve. Bring Member card if you have one. If challenged we can escape. Some long grass and lots of sheep droppings. No stiles. Meet at start. 10.00. Details by email and WhatsApp.

B- Walk, Thursday July 10 - Dolwyddelan circuit from Dolwyddelan station cp (£) 6mls / 1200 ft

Start point Dolwyddelan railway station car park (£small charge), Map OL18 Landranger or 115 Explorer, grid ref SH 737 522 /// northward. obstinate. insulated

A straightforward circular walk starting at station car park at Dolwyddelan railway station. Heading south along Sarn Helen roman road towards Tan y Bwlch 734 498 /// pillows. pavilions. tolls. Then a steepish climb to just below Pen y Benar 732 503 /// enough. stops. often. Although this a well signposted footpath, last year it was very overgrown so suggest trousers not shorts. Coffee break. Then following a vague path in a north westerly direction to cross over the A470 road (be aware fast traffic) to have lunch break at Pont Rufeing / Roman Bridge railway station 714 515 /// centrally. passenger. debut'. Finally following single track road and path back to Dolwyddelan via the remains of castle.

Meet at Wales Hawarden car park to leave at 08.30.

C- Walk, Tuesday July 15, Heswall Dales, 4 to 5 mls / ca. 250 ft

The walk starts at 10.00 from the car park opposite the Yot cafe at the bottom of Banks Rd, lower Heswall. It explores Heswall Dales. No unusual hazards. W3W: faster.assure.went

A* Walk, Thursday July 17, Pen yr Ole Wen. Carnedd Dafydd and Carnedd Llewelyn, 10.3 mls / 4180 ft.

Starting at the car park at Gwern Gof Isaf farm (£5 charge) Grid Ref: SH685603 / What 3 Words : ducks.height.flags.

We take a track parallel to the A5, close to the base of Tryfan, before crossing to make a steady climb up Pen yr Ole Wen (3,210 ft). From the summit we then follow a broad ridge taking in both Carnedd Dafydd (3,425 ft) and Carnedd Llewelyn (3,490 ft). This is a rewarding walk, with extensive views across the Snowdonia ranges including The Glyders and The Carnedds, and also over to Anglesey, but it is a long walk with challenging elements, including sections of scrambling – both ascending and descending - and crossing scree surfaces. It is unlikely we will be completed before 5.00 pm and so a later than usual finish should be expected. The walk is only suitable in good weather conditions, and so will not proceed if there is the prospect of rain or high winds.

D Walk, Tuesday July 22, Burton Woods from Gladstone Hall, 2.9 mls / 200 ft

B Walk, Thursday July 24, Cefn Du circuit north from Bodfari 8.5miles / 1600 ft

A Walk, Thursday July 31, Cnicht & Moelwyn Mawr from Croesor, 8 mls / 3000 ft

This walk has only had a partial recce recently, due to dangerous high winds. So please only come if you accept that. Details here:

Download the GPX in advance as there is no signal at Croesor.

There is a bit of a scramble towards the summit of Cnicht as well as a fairly narrow ridge. Apart from that there are no unusual mountain walking hazards. There is an obvious cut out between the two summits, leading straight back down to the village.

The drive is about 1 hour 45 mins from Hawarden, options being via Bala or Beddgelert. Details to follow.

D Walk, Thursday August 7, Circuit around Raby & Hinderton fm the Wheatsheaf. 4 mls flat, possibility of lunch there afterwards.
