Walk Grading by points score:

1 point per mile; 1 point per 500ft ascent;
 0 - 5+ for terrain/conditions
 A 15 - 20 points (NB *=includes scramble and/or exposure to steep drops)
 B 10 - 15 points
 C 5 - 10 points
 D = Short easy walk normally 4mls max
 S = A shorter and much slower option to the main 'A' walk,
 not necessarily a summit. May be on rough terrain.

Walk Descriptions:

B walk Wednesday 24th August Stipperstones Leader John Dornie

This walk encompasses part of the Shropshire Way. It consists of undulating paths in rural Shropshire plus the Stipperstones Ridge. The path along the ridge is composed of rocks of all shapes and sizes requiring care and concentration. Stout footwear with ankle support and walking pole(s) are recommended. But don't be deterred – it includes Shropshire's second highest point (Manstone Rock at 1759 ft.) plus Devils Chair, Cranbury Rock, Nipstone Rock and the Rock, with panoramic views in all directions (on a clear day!)

Hope this does not deter anyone. The drive is approx. 60 mls. 1 hour 22 min from Toby Inn

C Walk Thursday 25th August near Whitford leader David Cross

The starting point is SJ129788 dizzy.eyeliner.holiday. The walk is relatively short no more than 7 miles on field footpaths, bridle ways and quiet lanes. It's best described as a scenic walk using field footpaths and bridle ways. There are two modest hills, 3 or 4 stiles and one gate to be scaled but nothing difficult. Part of the walk is through woodland where the paths could be muddy if we have a lot of rain. There are some nettles around so wear shorts at your own risk! Good views across the estuary enhance a pleasant country walk of around 7 miles.

B walk Wednesday 31st August Trelawnyd Leader Geoff Beard. car park (FOC) near 8 High Street Trelawnyd LL18 6PB, which is just South of Prestatyn. Trelawnyd, Marian Ffrith, Gwenysgor.

The car park (free) is located half way up High Street, Trelawnyd on the right. We head South first, skirting the far end of the Clwyds. Expect a number of stiles, some in poor condition or overgrown. Some paths were also overgrown when recced mid June. There are two sections of ascent but nothing too difficult and no exposure. Some sections follow the Offa's Dyke route, also the Clwydian Way. There are a number of good view points, including looking out to sea over Prestatyn. If the weather is poor the walk could be shortened to 7 miles. For those who would like liquid refreshment after, the Crown Inn is a good place to stop.

D walk Thursday 1st September. North Wirral Coastal path. Leader Margaret Boulton

A flat walk starting from Leasowe Common car park
